## Primary Computing Package



Our Primary Computing package combines in-school INSET, centre based CPD and twilight networks. Our package enables schools to have a sustained programme, which supports whole school development.

#### **Centre Based CPD Courses**

We run regular and ongoing professional learning at our professional development centres in Norwich and Kings Lynn. Our programmes focus on equipping teachers with specialist skills and knowledge that have direct applications in the classroom.

#### **Twilight Computing Subject Leader Meetings**

Each term, we will host a two hour twilight network meeting aimed at supporting Computing Subject Leaders. These will run in Norwich and Kings Lynn.

#### **CPD INSET - In school session**

The package includes a CPD session in-school for up to 25 members of staff, offering support in one of the following areas:

- Online Safety update for staff
- Focus on teaching one of the three strands of the computing curriculum (Computer Science, Information Technology or Digital Literacy)
- Using iPads effectively in the classroom
- Using technology to support cross-curricular learning

All schools purchasing the Computing Package will also be entitled to a **10% discount** on any other Computing related product.
